

1. NOW THIS MOU WITNESS AS UNDER:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between KSRM College of Engineering and Suraj Krishna Greeneries for the social cause of recycling of Dry Waste and Environment Protection through recycling.

2. Time period: This MoU shall be for a period of Three years commencing from the date of signing of this MoU.

3. Roles and Responsibilities of KSRM:

- a. To ensure source segregation of dry and wet waste at college premises through its Teaching staff, housekeeping staff and Students.
- b. KSRM will give away any kind of paper waste, plastic waste and other dry recyclable waste to Suraj Krishna Greeneries at price agreed mutually.

Suraj Krishna will pay as rates mentioned below:

White paper & News Paper: Rs.10/- per kg.

Atta: Rs.3/- per Kg.

Carton Boxes: Rs.7/- per kg.

Hard Plastic (Pipes, Chairs, White drink bottles): Rs.12/- per kg.

Color drinking bottles: Rs.3/- per kg.

Low grade plastic: Rs.2/- per kg.

Iron: Rs.14/- per Kg.

- c. KSRM College of Engineering shall **form Swachh WOW club** in the college with Student Volunteers and adopt nearby Schools or Colonies to promote Source Segregation through student volunteers.
- d. KSRM College of Engineering shall provide students for **Internship** in WOW Program.
- e. KSRM College of Engineering shall **motivate students** to bring dry recyclables like paper, plastic, metal etc. from their home and donate to WOW initiative.
- f. KSRM College of Engineering will be put-up **color-coded bins** for waste segregation at different points in college premises.

4. Roles and Responsibilities of Suraj Krishna Greeneries:

- a. ITC-WOW team will impart training to the students and housekeeping staff on source **segregation** and through them inculcate the habit of source segregation among the other students.
- b. Suraj Krishna Greeneries will collect dry recyclable waste and old records from KSRM and bring to the Hub for sorting and baling of the material collected and dispatch to respective recycling industries.
- c. Suraj Krishna Greeneries shall coordinate with ITC and undertake necessary measures for dispatch of the sorted recyclables for recycling at its own cost.
- d. Suraj Krishna Greeneries will make payment to KSRM College of Engineering directly into their accounts for the dry recyclable waste collected against the accurate weighment and the type or category of the dry waste. The payment shall be made no later than 15 days from

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the date of payment request raised by the college. Franchisee on the request of KSRM may give New Notebooks and Stationery against the value of dry recyclable waste lifted.

5. Performance of Obligations

- a. The details laid out in this MoU, notwithstanding the essence and spirit of this MoU is an understanding between KSRM and Suraj Krishna Greeneries.
- b. Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or sent by way of e-mail to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out in this contract or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other.

6. Execution of this Agreement shall be deemed to be

- a. A confirmation by both the parties that no benefit, either in cash or kind has been provided by either party to the other party or to any officer or employee, or any relative / associate of any officer or employee of either party or of any of their associate institutions / companies in order to enter into this Agreement, and
- b. An undertaking by both the parties not to provide any benefit, either in cash or kind to any officer / employee / relative / associate of any officer or employee of either party as reward or consideration either for entering into this MoU or other matter relating to this Agreement.

7. Other Terms:

Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations here under, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earth quakes, explosions, acts of God or State or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any Governmental body.

8. Dispute Resolution: It is understood by both the parties that this Agreement is for a social cause and not to make any profit out of the

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understanding. The Parties covenant that they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations in their conduct pursuant to this Agreement. Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be first attempted to settle amicably between the parties.

9. Arbitration

Any dispute which is not resolved amicably shall be finally settled by binding arbitration in respect to the matters concerning to the MoU with the Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the mutual consent of both the parties. The Parties agree that the decision or award resulting from arbitration shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

Pending the submission of and / or decision on a dispute, the Parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with such arbitration award.

10. Governing and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement is subjected to the Jurisdiction of Courts at Vijayawada. The parties shall agree that it will not make use of, disseminate, or in any way disclose any confidential information to any person, firm or business. Furthermore, the existence of any discussions, negotiations or agreements in progress between the parties shall not be released to any form of public media without written approval of both parties.

11. Amendments

This Agreement and the Schedules together constitute a complete and exclusive understanding of the terms of the Agreement between the Parties on the subject hereof and no amendment or modification hereto shall be valid and effective unless agreed to by all the Parties hereto and evidenced in writing.

12. NOTICE /Termination

Any notice required to be given hereunder shall be given in writing at the address of each party set forth as below in this agreement or to such other address either party may substitute by written notice to the other. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving 30 days written notice to the other party.

India, the Second Party, use to recycle the electronic components by making use of old electronics components to produce new products and it also, dispose the unused E-waste to final recycling at the recyclers end.

Whereas, both **KSRM College of Engineering(A)**, **JPS Traders** and now recognizing the importance of handling of E-waste management to maintain clean environment by responsibly discarding recyclable E-waste in time to time. Work together to form an eco-balancing environment for creating an eco-friendly environment in the campus.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made here in and of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which both **KSRM College of Engineering(A)** and **JPS Traders**, hereby acknowledges, agree to sign a memorandum of understanding (MoU) by the Principal and Managing Director of JPS Traders.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To create an eco-friendly environment in the campus.
2. To utilize the E-waste from the campus at the optimum level and further to recycle in manufacturing process.
3. To exchange/dispose various type of electronic goods.

ACTIVITIES:

- E-Waste Management: Present Scenario, Electronic goods are using at optimum level, the minor repairs are set right by the Laboratory assistants and teaching staff; and the major repairs are handled by the Technical Assistant and are reused.
- The major e-waste such as written in MoU are instruments/equipment, CRTs, Printers, Computers.
- Electronic gadgets, circuits, kits have been returned off on regular basis
- The awareness programs have to be undertaken in the institution where the students are made aware of the E-waste management techniques

NOW THIS MOU witnesses as follows;

I. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap –

The term E-Waste will refer to be the below mentioned electrical and electronic waste, the term Metal Scrap will refer as Ferrous and Non-ferrous Metal Scrap, the term Battery Scrap will refer to be the Lead Acid Batteries and all types other battery scraps, for the purpose of this Agreement which includes;

- a) Computers & Peripherals (CPU, Keyboard, Mouse& Monitor)
- b) Laptops
- c) Servers
- d) PCBs
- e) Mobiles or Communication devices
- f) Mother Boards (Computers &Laptops)
- g) Security Devices
- h) Telecom Equipment
- i) Printers & Scanners
- j) Scrap Electronic
- k) Electrical Equipment's
- l) Data cables &wires m) Batteries n) CD/DVD
- m) Battery Scrap (all types)
- n) Ferrous and Non-ferrous Metal Scrap
- o) Industrial Machineries
- p) Electronic Appliances.... etc.

II. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

1. JPS TRADERS shall collect, transport, and dispose the E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap collected from the premises. It shall be the responsibility of JPS TRADERS to demagnetize the hard disks before disposing them off in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement. If the hard disks come along with the CPU, the activity would be taken care by JPS TRADERS at free of cost. However, in case of an exclusive consignment of hard disks for demagnetization by the Generator. In case, it will be chargeable in accordance with the terms of the contract.
2. The Generator shall appoint a dedicated representative who will be responsible for operational, delivery and day to day management of the Service and act as the principal point of contact under this Agreement. Any notice seeking clarification served on such representative shall be deemed to serve on the Party concerned. The representative of the Generator shall sign Form 06 under the compliance of the Waste Management & Handling Rules, 2016, and such other required documents for acknowledging the Waste/Scrap being handed over to JPS TRADERS.
3. The Generator shall segregate the E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap at one designated place within the premises from where the representatives of JPS TRADERS shall collect the Waste/Scrap with prior permission from the undersigned. All the segregated E-Waste/Metal

Scrap/Battery Scrap shall be stored in the appropriate bins and/or container as prescribed under the applicable law and JPS TRADERS shall not be liable for any damage caused due to in appropriate storage of Waste/Scrap at the premises by the Generator.

4. The E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap collected shall be weighed under the presence of both the Parties at the nearest weighment center available as identified by the Parties. The weighment of the E-waste shall be done in the presence of the representatives of both the Parties and both shall acknowledge such weighment slip generated. In case of any discrepancy in the weighment as per delivery challan and the weighment slip, the details as per weighment slip shall be considered for payment by JPS TRADERS.
5. The Generator liability shall cease once the E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap has been collected by JPS TRADERS from its premises except for any non-disclosure of any material information known to the Generator with regard to E-Waste from SCPL during the handover of such E-Waste. It is specifically agreed and understood that compliances of applicable law during transportation and disposal of E-Waste shall be exclusive responsibility of the JPS TRADERS.
6. JPS TRADERS shall, issue a safe destruction certificate as prescribed under applicable laws within fifteen (15) days from receipt of such request.

III. PAYMENTS

1. JPS TRADERS shall pay an amount of Rs. _____ inclusive of all taxes per each kilogram for payment of E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap collected shall be as per the weighment slip submitted and accepted by JPS TRADERS.
2. The payment shall be made by JPS TRADERS within thirty (30) days of the collection of E-Waste in the form of electronic transfer/ cheque. JPS TRADERS may withhold any payment in case of any dispute regarding the weighment of E-Waste/Metal Scrap/Battery Scrap and any such withholding of payment shall under this clause shall not be considered as a material breach of this Agreement.

IV. COMMENCEMENT AND TENURE

This memorandum of understanding (MoU), shall become effective on the date of signing for Five years unless either side give the prior written notice of its desire to revise or terminate the MoU at least three months prior to its termination. Amendments will do by the stakeholders of this agreement and dispute resolution by the both parties.
