3. It is understood that during the course of this MoU it may be necessary for either parties to disclose confidential/proprietary information to the other. The disclosure of any such information or data between the parties shall be made pursuant to an executed Confidentiality Agreement.

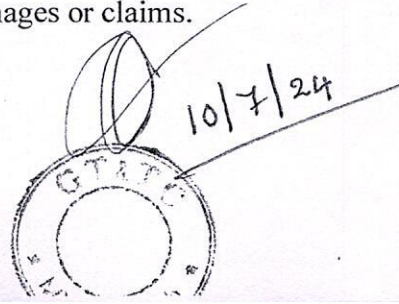

Annexure-I

Intellectual Property Rights

1.1 Definition of Intellectual Property

For the purposes of this Agreement, "Intellectual Property" includes, but is not limited to, patents, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, designs, inventions, know-how, and any other proprietary rights.

1.2 Ownership

- (a) Pre-existing Intellectual Property: Each Party retains ownership of its Intellectual Property existing prior to the commencement of this Agreement ("Pre-existing IP").
- (b) Newly Created Intellectual Property: Any Intellectual Property developed jointly by the Parties during the term of this Agreement shall be jointly owned, unless otherwise agreed in writing. Intellectual Property developed independently by a Party during the term of this Agreement remains the property of the developing Party.

1.3 Grant of Rights

- (a) License to Pre-existing IP: Party A grants Party B a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use its Pre-existing IP solely for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement.
- (b) Scope of License: The license granted herein is non-transferable and non-sublicensable, except with prior written consent from the licensor.


1.4 Use of Intellectual Property

Each Party agrees to use the other Party's Intellectual Property only as permitted under this Agreement and in compliance with all applicable laws.

1.5 Protection of Intellectual Property

- (a) Confidentiality: Each Party shall maintain the confidentiality of the other Party's Intellectual Property and shall not disclose it to any third party without the prior written consent of the owning Party.
- (b) Infringement: Each Party shall promptly notify the other of any unauthorized use or infringement of the other Party's Intellectual Property and shall cooperate in taking reasonable steps to protect such Intellectual Property.

1.6 Infringement Claims

- (a) Notification: In the event of any infringement or unauthorized use of the Intellectual Property, the Parties shall notify each other promptly.
- (b) Enforcement: The owner of the Intellectual Property shall have the primary right to enforce its Intellectual Property rights against third parties. The other Party shall cooperate and assist in such enforcement at the owner's expense.


1.7 Termination and Survival

- (a) Post-Termination Rights: Upon termination of this Agreement, each Party shall cease using the other Party's Intellectual Property, except as permitted by this Clause.
- (b) Survival: The provisions of this Clause 5 shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

1.8 Warranties and Indemnities

- (a) Warranties: Each Party warrants that it owns its Intellectual Property and that such Intellectual Property does not infringe the rights of any third party.
- (b) Indemnities: Each Party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other Party from any claims arising from the use of the indemnifying Party's Intellectual Property.

Annexure-II

Limitation of Liability

2.1 Limitation of Liability

Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, neither Party shall be liable to the other Party for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, revenue, data, or use, incurred by either Party or any third party, whether in an action in contract, tort, strict liability, or imposed by statute, or arising from the performance or non-performance of any aspect of this Agreement, even if the Party has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

2.2 Maximum Liability

The total cumulative liability of each Party to the other Party for any and all claims, actions, demands, and proceedings of any kind arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, whether in contract, tort, strict liability, or imposed by statute, shall not exceed the total amount paid or payable by [the other Party] under this Agreement during the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the event giving rise to such liability.

2.3 Exclusions from Liability

The limitations of liability set forth in this Clause 6 shall not apply to:

- (a) Breach of Confidentiality Obligations: Any damages or liability arising from a breach of the confidentiality obligations set forth in this Agreement.
- (b) Indemnification Obligations: Any indemnification obligations set forth in this Agreement.
- (c) Willful Misconduct or Gross Negligence: Any damages or liability arising from the willful misconduct or gross negligence of a Party.
- (d) Violation of Intellectual Property Rights: Any damages or liability arising from the violation or infringement of the intellectual property rights of a Party.

2.4 Third-Party Claims

Neither Party shall be liable for any third-party claims against the other Party except to the extent expressly provided in this Agreement.

2.5 Survival

The provisions of this Clause 6 shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

Annexure-III Survival of Terms

3.1 Software License Agreements

The terms and conditions of any applicable software license agreements entered into between the Parties shall continue to remain in full force and effect, even after the termination or expiration of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). This includes, but is not limited to, provisions related to:

- License Scope: The scope of the license granted, including any restrictions on use, distribution, and modification of the software.
- License Duration: The duration of the license, specifying whether it is perpetual or time-limited.
- License Fees: Any fees associated with the use of the software, including payment terms and conditions.
- Use of Software: Permitted uses and any limitations on the use of the software by the licensee.
- Termination: Conditions under which the software license can be terminated and the consequences of such termination.

3.2 Confidentiality

The confidentiality obligations set forth in this MoU shall survive its termination or expiration. Both Parties agree to

- Non-Disclosure: Not disclose any Confidential Information received from the other Party to any third party without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party.
- Use of Confidential Information: Use Confidential Information only for the purposes of fulfilling their obligations under this MoU and not for any other purpose.
- Protection of Confidential Information: Take all reasonable measures to protect the confidentiality of the information received, including, but not limited to, restricting access to employees, contractors, and agents who need to know such information for the purposes of this MoU and who are bound by confidentiality obligations.
- Duration: Maintain the confidentiality of the information for a period of [insert duration, e.g., two years] following the termination or expiration of this MoU, or as specified in the applicable software license agreements, whichever is longer.
- Return or Destruction of Information: Upon termination or expiration of this MoU, return or destroy all Confidential Information received from the other Party, except where retention is required by law or as necessary to comply with the terms of the software license agreements.
